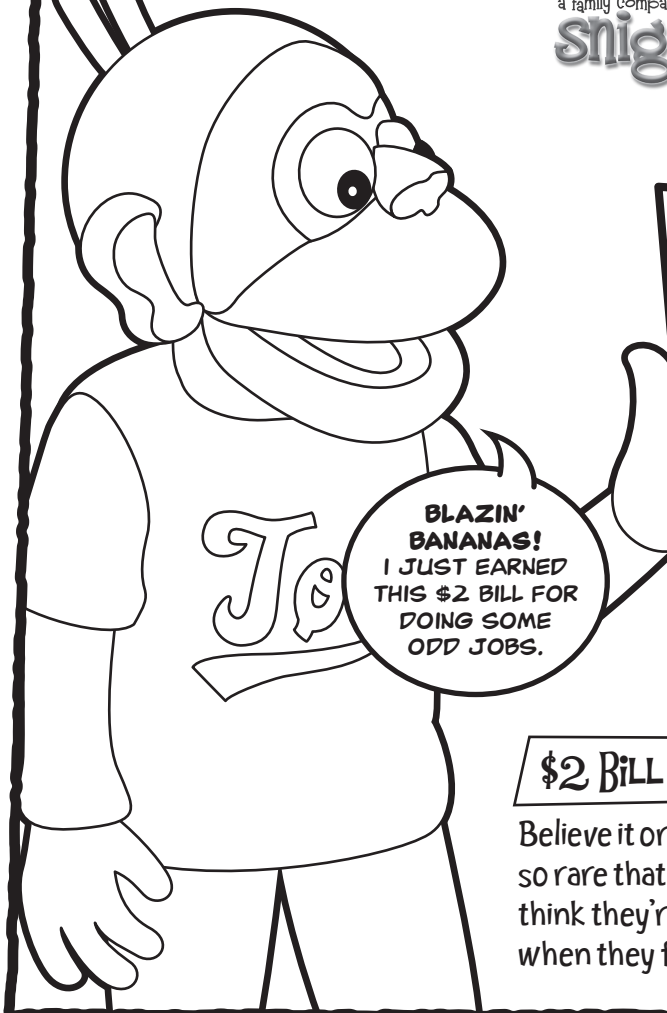

\$2 Bill Fun Facts

Believe it or not, \$2 bills are so rare that some people still think they're counterfeit when they first see them.

In 1989, Geneva Steel near Provo, Utah, paid its employee bonuses with \$2 bills to highlight the importance of the steel mill to the local economy. That fact became obvious after the rare bills began appearing at merchants throughout the community.

The US Bureau of Engraving and Printing continues to print \$2 bills, including 230 million of them in 2006. Even so, \$2 bills make up just 1% of all US bills in circulation.
